CAPTION	Each of the DEW Line four main sites in the Canadian Arctic has a landing strip for aircraft that supply the auxiliary sites. Fuel to keep these aircraft flying all year around is shipped to the base during the short summer by sealift and stacked outside in barrels. To refuel the aircraft a snow plough is used to clear the snow at the fuel dump, then the barrels are man handled onto a trailer and towed to the aircraft. This photo was taken at a radar site near Cape Perry on the southern shores of the Beaufort Sea. Eskimos are used mainly for this type of outside work.

LOCATION	Cape Perry
CAPTION	At the DEW Line control site near Cape Perry on the southern shores of the Beaufort Sea, fresh water is at a premium and has to be hauled by truck from a frozen lake nearly three miles from the base. The camp uses more then a 1,250,000 gallons of fresh water annually. During the winter a hole must be chopped through six feet of ice to reach the water. This truck carries about 1,000 gallons of water in one load and keeping the camp supplied with water is the responsibility of one of four Eskimos employed on the radar unit. The natives are opening the water hole with iron bars while W/C J.G. Filteau, centre, commanding officer of the Air Force squadron at Laval University in Quebec City watches the operation. Temperature when this photograph was taken was -38 degrees and there was a 30 mile an hour wind blowing off the Beaufort Sea.

CAPTION Breaking the permafrost - It may not be rock, but the ground here at the site for a DEW Line installation , frozen solid all year round in this "permafrost" region requires a pneumatic drill to make a dent in its surface. Hard at work are the drill operator and helper. In this region, mud and water forms a foundation for piles supporting the installation. Once the hole is drilled and piles sunk, mud and water is poured in, allowed to freeze, forming a base as solid as cement.

CAPTION Recreation facilities are sharply curtailed for RCAF personnel now on duty on the DEW Line in the Canadian Arctic but for those who like curling and can stand the bitter cold there is ample opportunity to practice the sport. And that's exactly what the members of the main control site intend to do. They have built the only curling rink on the Canadian sector of the Line. Using blocks of snow and timbers left over from construction days they have built a windbreak and covered it with canvas. With plenty of patience, hundreds of gallons of water and natures own deep freeze they now have the only two sheets of curling ice on the Canadian sector of the DEW Line. Trying out the new ice are (left to right) F/O W.H. Taylor, F/O J.C. Eeggenberger, F/O G.J.A. Morchain and F/O L.K. Neilson. Temperatures often drop below 40 degrees below zero in the unheated building.

LOCATION Hall Lake  
CAPTION Almost next door to the DEW Line site near Hall Lake is a small hospital that is run by what are probably two of the busiest women in Canada. Operated by Miss Vera Roberts, the tiny hospital is the most northerly in the Eastern Arctic. In a small building about three miles from the DEW Line site, the hospital stands alone on the wind swept tundra where the temperature often stands at 40 below zero for days. Miss Roberts, is assisted by Miss Ivy Hepden, who is a nurse's aide. Eskimos and their children travel as far as 200 miles by dog team for medical attention. Miss Roberts and Miss Hepden are the only two white women for 500 miles but they are not too concerned as they are in direct contact with the nearby DEW Line site. This small Eskimo child, Irokkittok, was admitted to the hospital suffering from a chest condition.
